

Healthy School Act of 2000

Notice to all students, parents/guardians and employees of the Manzanita Elementary School District:

Assembly Bill 2260 went into effect on January 1, 2001. This legislation enacted Education Code Sections 17608, *et seq.*, and 48908.3, which require, among other things, that school districts notify parents and staff about the use of pesticides at school. The purpose of this legislation is to reduce exposure to toxic pesticides through information and application of an integrated pest management system at schools. Towards this end, and pursuant to the requirements of this legislation, please be advised of the following:

The Manzanita Unified School District expects to use the following pesticides at its campus during the upcoming year:

Parents/guardians of the Manzanita Elementary School District can register with the District Office to receive notification of individual pesticide applications by calling (530) 846-5594. Persons who register for this notification shall be notified at least seventy-two (72) hours prior to the application, except in emergencies, and will be provided the name and active ingredient(s) of the pesticide as well as the intended date of application.
