Attendance

The cold and flu season is upon us. Please remember to call Mrs. Smith when your child is not going to be in school, or you can also send a note for your child to take to the office when they return to school after an absence. Be sure to have your child cough into their sleeve and wash their hands with soap several times a day.

Tardy Reminder

Many students are tardy to school; arriving to their class after 8:20 a.m. Please make sure your child is at school no later than 8:15 a.m. Class instruction starts promptly at 8:20 a.m. If your child is not in the classroom at 8:20 a.m. they are tardy. Attendance is critical, not only for academic achievement, but also to teach our children the importance of showing up on time and being punctual, a characteristic of a responsible citizen. Manzanita Belief #2 states "Consistent personal accountability is essential in developing responsible citizens". Parents, it is your responsibility to make sure that your child arrives to school on time.



Safety First



Please remember that we have many children who live along Evans Reimer Road and walk to and from school. The speed limit is 35 mph. Please be cautious and follow the speed limit when driving along this road between the school and Highway 99. Help keep our children safe.

We have also gotten numerous reports from concerned parents and staff that parents are dropping off students in areas where the students has to walk across the street or parking lot unattended. Please remember that we have no one on duty in the mornings to walk your child across the street or parking lot. It is your responsibility to make sure that you drop them off in a safe area where they will not be crossing the street or parking lot unescorted.

Halloween Parade

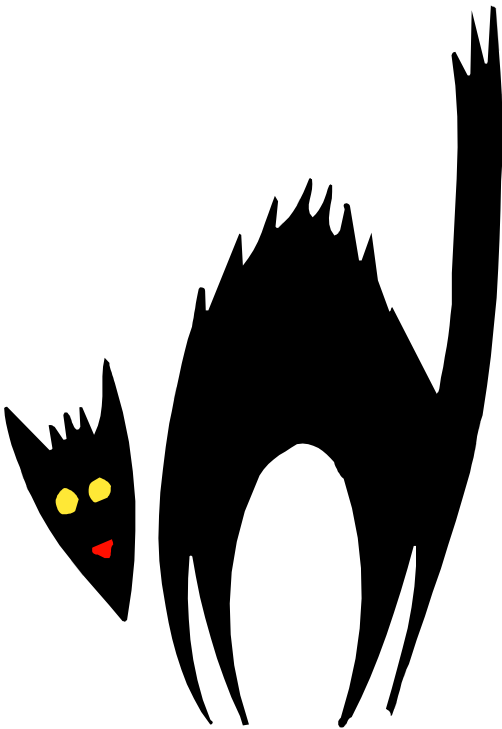
**The Halloween Parade will be on Monday,
