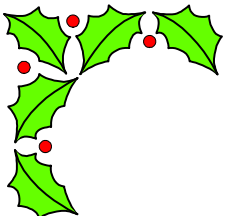

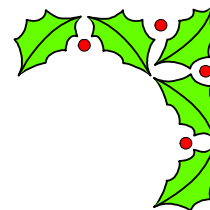

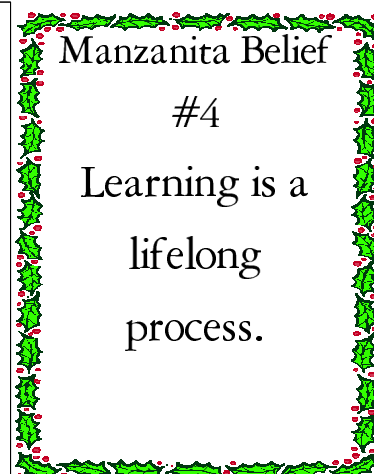

Attendance Matters

Your child's teachers will do their best to help your child learn and succeed in school. But there's one thing *only you can do*--get him/her to school *on time* every day. Children who don't attend school regularly fall behind. Show your child and his/her teachers that you know attendance counts.

The good news is...Manzanita School attendance has been great so far this year. Keep up the good work! But.....there is one area that needs improvement.....***Tardies!***

A survey was done recently asking our teachers what happens in their class during the first 10 minutes of the day. These are the results:

- * Attendance and breakfast/lunch counts are done and turned into the office.
- * The daily bulletin is read to make students aware of school events, timelines, athletic practices, etc.
- * Last night's homework is reviewed/corrected and graded.
- * Tonight's homework is explained.
- * Students work on accelerated math or warm-up math activities

Teachers agree that within the first minute of class, students are hard at work. Math is the first subject of the day in all classes. It takes about ten minutes for students to complete warm-up activities and then the teacher will begin the math lesson for the day. It disrupts the learning of other students when the teacher has to stop and help students who are continually coming into class late.

A calm and happy school morning begins the night before. Go to bed knowing everything's in order with these tips:

- * Check the weather forecast and help your child choose clothes, coats, and shoes.
- * Have him/her stow her backpack by the door. Be sure he/she has put in homework, lunch money, and permission slips.
- * Together, plan breakfast, and pack a healthy snack or lunch.
- * Test your youngster for tomorrow's quiz one last time.

Hint: In the morning, set the oven timer to go off five minutes before your child has to leave. That will be the signal to put on socks and shoes and head out the door.
